Classes will be at the Travis County Sheriff's Office Ruiz Building, 5555 Airport Blvd, Austin, Texas, 78751. Classes will begin at 8:00AM, Monday, March 23rd and will be dismissed at 12:00PM, Friday, March 27th.

Experienced and knowledgeable Crime Prevention Specialists from around Central Texas will follow the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education (TCLEOSE) curriculum for this 40-hour Basic Crime Prevention course. Forty (40) hours of TCLEOSE credit will be awarded to students completing the course. Class hours will be 8:00AM to 5:00PM most days. Security Surveys will be performed with written reports submitted and graded.

Registration fee is \$150 per person, which includes a student notebook, a CTCPA carrying case and a one year (2009) membership to the Central Texas Crime Prevention Association and the Texas Crime Prevention Association. This will entitle students to attend monthly CTCPA meetings and two TCPA conferences a year, plus receive CTCPA monthly newsletters and any TCPA publications, as well as networking opportunities with fellow Crime Prevention Practitioners from throughout the state. (Students attending from one of the other TCPA regions will be members of that region instead of CTCPA.)
