Sheriff's Detectives Investigate A Possible Drowning

On July 17, 2010, at 11:24pm, Deputies were called to 23917 Pedernales Drive in reference to a missing swimmer. They met with Austin/Travis County EMS, LCRA, Texas Parks and Wildlife, Pedernales Fire and StarFlight in an effort to locate a man who was last seen in the Pedernales River. Witnesses stated that the man was missing after swinging from the dock on a rope swing into the water. A search was conducted until 3:40am but the man could not be located.

He was identified as,

Todd Mobley, Date of Birth 9-19-1961,

of Pasadena, TX,

On July 18, 2010, at about 8:45am, the Sheriff's Under Water Recovery Team started their search of the river and at about 9:20am they recovered the body of Mr. Mobley in 14 feet of water, about 50 feet from the dock.

Detectives will be working with the Medical Examiner's Office to determine the cause and manner of death, however, all evidence collected in this case so far indicates an accidental death.
